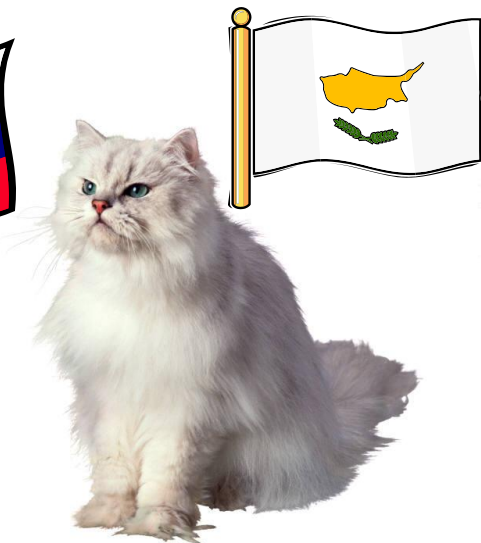


Terry's adventure
